Science

We will be focusing on understanding Plants. We will carry out investigations into how plants grow best and how water is transported around a plant. We will learn about the parts of a flowering plant and the functions of each part in order for a plant to grow and survive.

Maths

In Maths we will begin with developing our knowledge of addition and subtraction before moving onto multiplication and division.

We will then focus on applying the skills we have learnt to solve real-life problems. We will use reasoning skills to solve a variety of different problems.

We will be learning the 4 and 8 times tables. Please practice these at home.

COMPUTING:

We will be looking at word processing and creating a poster page relating to our Science or History topics.

History:

In History we will be continuing to explore the Ancient Civilisations mostly focusing on Ancient Egypt. We will look at the importance of the Egyptian Gods and what the Egyptians believed about them. We will also look at what the Egyptians and the other civilisations invented and why they are important to us today.

PSHE:

As part of our PSHE topic this half term we will be exploring what keeps us safe and discussing how to have a healthy body and mind. We will look at keeping ourselves safe in school and at home and what to do if we ever feel unsafe.

RE:

In RE we will be discussing the question: 'Why is the Bible so important to Christians?'

Homework:

Homework will be given out on the Link Learning grids again. Children should complete the Maths, English and Reading activities each week and then choose one of the other 6 activities to complete.

Music:

We will continue to take part in our Ukelele lessons with Trafford Music Service. There will be a concert at the end of term.

PE:

PE will take place every Tuesday and Friday afternoon. There will be a tag rugby focus on Fridays and Dodgeball on Tuesdays. Full PE kits must be worn and left in school which must include trainers or pumps.
