Maths

In Maths we will continue to develop and strengthen our knowledge of multiplication and division and quick recall of times tables.

We will also be continue with our focus of fractions learning how to add, subtract, multiply and convert between improper and mixed numbers. We will then focus move on to decimals and percentages.

We will continue with our 'Daily 10' arithmetic questions.

Science

We will be introduced to a new topic 'animals including humans.' This topic will include learning about the digestive system and how humans digest food. We will also be looking at the function of teeth and food chains.

COMPUTING:

We will continue to learn about programming through apps such as Hopscotch and Scratch.

PSHE:
