

Vocabulary	
material	The matter of which something is made from.
plastic	A synthetic material.
wood	A hard material that forms the main substance of the trunk or branches of a tree.
glass	A hard substance, typically transparent or translucent.
hard	Solid, firm, not easily broken or bent.
smooth	An even and regular surface.
elastic	Able to go back to its' original shape after being stretched.
opaque	No light passes through.
transparent	Almost all light passes through.
translucent	Only some light passes through.
