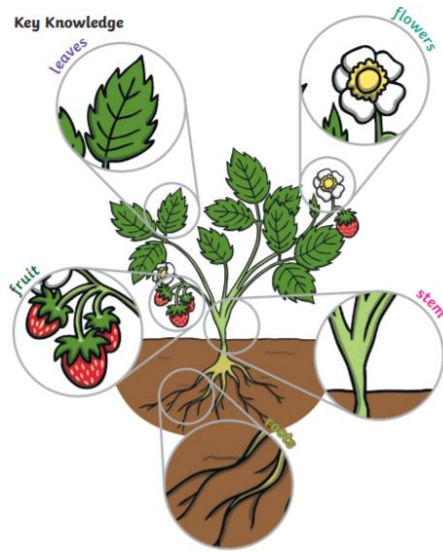


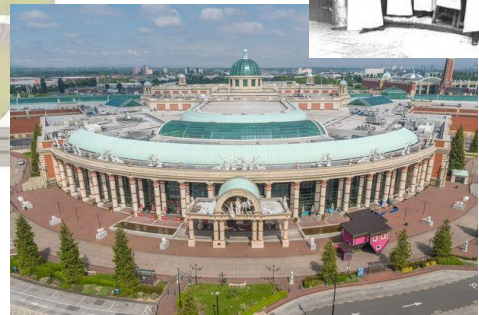
# Knowledge Organiser - Year 1 - Autumn 1

Key Knowledge	
1.	Parts of common trees: Crown, leaves, twig, branch, trunk and roots.
2.	Parts of common plants: roots, stem, leaf, flower, seed.
3.	<b>Deciduous trees</b> lose their leaves in the autumn every year.
4.	<b>Evergreen trees</b> have green leaves all year round

Wild plants	A wild plant seed grows where it falls. It doesn't need to be planted or cared for.
Garden plants	Plants that people have chosen to grow in their gardens.
Weed	Weeds are wild plants that grow in places people don't want them.
Deciduous	A deciduous tree loses its leaves each year.
Evergreen	An evergreen tree keeps its leaves all year round, even in winter.
