Vocabulary	
Adaption	Animals and plants are adapted to their environment. Their bodies are suited to the way they live.
Characteristics	A distinguishing trait, feature or quality.
Environment	The conditions in which a living thing exists.
Habitat	A natural environment or home of a variety of plants and animals.
Micro-habitat	A very small habitat, for example for woodlice under stones, logs or leaf litter.
Species	A group of closely related organisms that are similar to each other.

Living Things and their Habitats

A **habitat** is a place where living things, such as animals and plants, can find all of the things they need to survive.
