Maths

We start this half term with a focus on multiplication and division. We will be looking at multiples, factors and prime, squared and cubed numbers, before learning how to multiply and divide by 10, 100 and 1000.

. Then our focus will change to fractions.

COMPUTING:

We will be continuing our e-safety topic. Then we will start to develop our word processing skills, starting with Microsoft Word.

Science

This half term we will be learning about all things Space! We are excited to learn about the planets, the solar systems and the science behind what it is like to walk on the moon. During our studies we will be taking a close look at the sky to see what we can observe from outside our own planet.

PSHE:

In PSHE, our Time for Me topic focusses around living in the wider world. We will look closely at the decisions and risks we make with our money.

Mental health and well-being will also be an essential part of our daily Time to Be sessions.

RE:- Year 5 will be looking at what 'peace' is, with a focus on Christianity as we prepare for Christmas celebrations at the end of the term.

History:

In History we will be continuing to explore the question: 'What happened to Britain when the Romans left?' We will continue to discuss the changes in Britain between 410AD and 1066AD with a focus on the Viking invasions and settlements, up to the start of the Norman Conquest in 1066AD.

Music:

We will be looking at Jazz music and will learn about some of the instruments involved.

PE:

PE will take place every **Tuesday** and **Friday** afternoon, so the children will need to come to school in their PE kits on these days. There will be a dance focus on a Thursday and a games focus on Fridays (football).

Homework:

Link learning grids are handed out at the beginning of each term. Please complete one task each week, as well as doing weekly spelling, reading and times table practise weekly.
