Vocabulary

Plant	A living thing that grows in earth, in water, or on other plants. They usually has a stem, leaves, roots, and flowers.
Seed	A seed contains a miniature plant that can develop into a fully-grown plant.
Bulb	A bulb is the name given to the underground bud or stem of a seed plant
Grow	Growth is an increase in size of a plant.
Germination	Germination is the process by which seeds begin to grow into plants.

Plants

Plants can be grown from either **seeds** or **bulbs** and they grow into **mature plants** over time.

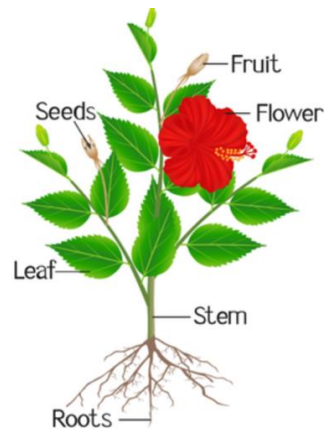
What do plants need to grow?

Plants need different things to grow and to be healthy.

They need a suitable amount of **water, light, and a suitable temperature** to stay healthy.

They should not have too much of any of these things as it will cause the plant to die.
