But that's not all. We offer our pupils an array of distinctive opportunities. We have a dedicated sports coach to enhance our physical education program, and in selected classes, we provide chess and music tuition. School Information

Breakfast Club

Our Breakfast Club starts at 8am. Children will enjoy a nutritious breakfast and the opportunity to play with their friends or complete their homework, if they choose.

School Meals

Meals at Barton Clough Primary School are provided by Sodexo. Our school menus are well balanced and varied, with choices to suit everyone. Children are welcome to bring their own packed lunch, but we ask that this is healthy.

School Uniform

Black trousers/skirt, navy v-neck sweatshirt with school logo, white shirt, navy and red tie, sensible black shoes, coat.

Black shorts, white polyester logo round neck t-shirt, pumps/trainers for outdoor games (plain black tracksuit and school jumper may be worn for outdoor games).
